Focused Area for Improvement	Key Improvement Priority
Quality of education	To improve Writing attainment in order to close the reading and writing attainment gap To improve 'Greater Depth' achievement in Maths by the end of Year 6
Behaviour and attitudes	To have an improved impact on the attendance of our Pupil Premium children across the school to improve some pupils' persistent absenteeism
Personal development	To develop whole school metacognition and self-regulated learning strategies (through Zones of Regulation/ Behaviour for Learning Curriculum). To continue to develop a Mental Health and well-being offer as part of the whole school hidden curriculum.
Leadership and management	Leaders to ensure that teachers use assessment strategies well in non- core subjects, identify misconceptions and work to fill knowledge-based gaps
Effectiveness of the early years provision	To re shape the EYFS curriculum so there are deliberate opportunities to support communication and language and purposeful ways to improve the children's executive function
