- We will follow our behaviour approach and contact the child's parents.

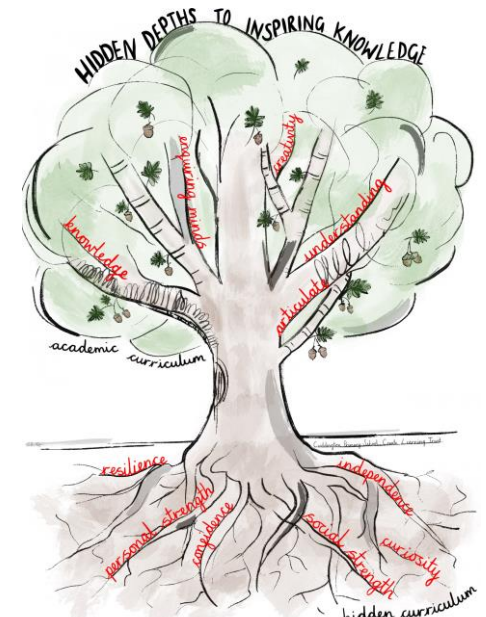

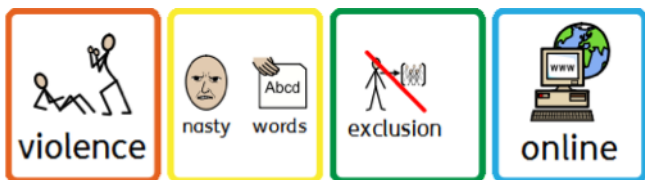

If You Are Being Bullied

DO.....

- Tell a trusted adult
- Tell them to STOP if you can
- Ignore them

- Do what they say
- Keep it a secret
- Get angry
